

General Passport Checklist

This information is for first time passport applicants 16 or older who are U.S. citizens. For more information go to <http://travel.state.gov>

- Fill out form DS-11
 - Use black ink or fill out online and print as two separate pages
 - If you make a mistake, you will need to complete a new form
 - The passport acceptance agent will attach the photograph
 - Signing the form must happen in the presence of the acceptance agent during the appointment

- Certified Birth Certificate
 - Should have the seal and signature of the state registrar
 - Should have the full names of applicant's parents
 - If you need to get a new birth certificate/official copy go to: <https://www.cdc.gov/nchs/w2w/index.htm>

- Photograph
 - Viking Travel does passport photos that meet government requirements

- Photo ID
 - If you have an out of state ID (not Alaskan) – secondary ID will be required

- The Department of State can only accept checks or money orders for passport books and cards. Call for current charges or go to travel.state.gov

- Separate payment to the library for processing and handling may be by credit, debit, cash or money order. Call for current charges or go to travel.state.gov

- Passport processing is available by appointment only.
